AND NOW, this 23rd day of June 2023, the Court hereby enters the following Order:

For the reasons stated in the Court's Opinion of this Date, the Defendants' Motion to Dismiss (ECF No. 36) is DENIED without prejudice, and the Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction (ECF No. 3) is GRANTED, but only to the following extent: subject to any further Order of this Court, the Acting Secretary of the Pennsylvania Department of Corrections, Laurel R. Harry (and any of her successors or others acting at her direction or behest, or otherwise exercising the authority of her office, and all other persons as described in Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(d)(2)), is strictly enjoined and ordered to take all necessary steps to restore the *status quo* as to the observance of the Eid holidays, Eid al-Fit and Eid al-Adha, by inmates resident at SCI-Albion as they existed in calendar year 2022, and to maintain such *status quo* as to such inmates and as to the Plaintiff until otherwise ordered by this Court. The Plaintiff shall post security in an amount and form as is otherwise ordered by this Court.
